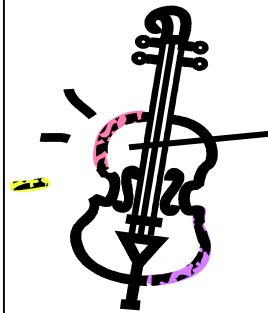

Changes to Payment of Fees:

As you may be aware, Louey retired from collecting payments at our Fleet centre in September and these payments will now be collected by the teachers as in our Farnham, Hook and Aldershot centres. It would help us enormously if fees could be sent to the Office in advance of the start of term. It is fine to post-date your cheque for the first week of term.

Alternatively, please ensure you have your cheque already written, with your child's name and class number on the back and hand it to the teacher at the first class of term. This will minimise the disruption to the lesson.

Term Dates:

This means that all Friday and Saturday classes will have one less class next term. Please check the fees carefully as children who attend on Fridays and Saturdays are cheaper by one class.
